Cover Letter. Please submit a cover letter requesting consideration of your Scholarship Application. You must be planning to attend a university/college in Illinois to be eligible.

Application. All sections of this application must be completed. The student must sign and date the application.

Essay. The student must write a 500-word essay on *"The Role of Township Government in Today's Society and in the Future"* that will include information from an interview of a township official. The township official interviewed **must** sign this application for student to be eligible.

Transcript. Submit an official high school transcript indicating your most recent academic work including fall semester 2014.
